Essential Duties

- Round continually inside the department, in patient rooms and halls when rooms are full and unavailable, and in the waiting areas where patients are triaged and waiting to be seen by a physician and attended by the nursing staff.
- Act as a liaison between physicians, nurses, technicians and social workers and patients, particularly when patients exhibit physical or mental changes from the time of triage and throughout the time they're either waiting to be seen or being treated.
- Ensure the maximum comfort for each patient as they arrive either by ambulance or offering a wheelchair at the front door if they walk in to register to be seen. During their patient stay in the department, provide warm blankets, administering basic hygiene to wounds that may need fresh soap

and water, buckets for patients with gastronomical issues, earplugs and eye masks to block the noise of a bustling ED and the light for patients who may have migraines and other conditions that strong lighting can exacerbate, access to the patient belongings closet to retrieve something that may have been misplaced or forgotten throughout patient stays.

- Empty the linen carts, clean patient beds and rooms, delete trash that may have been left during a patient stay. Always be on the watch for what hasn't been cleaned and ask Housekeeping to help with the cleanup.
- Transport patients to X-ray when there are staff shortages; transport patients from the waiting room in wheelchair to their assigned location. Always inform the Resource Nurse that the patient is ready to be seen
- Accompany patients who may arrive alone with a watchful eye, particularly on the elderly and/or patients with behavioral health issues.
- Attend to patient families who may have concerns and non-clinical questions that may be answered regarding the myriad services that Southcoast Health Care provides.
- Assist patients who may have trouble eating alone or who may request something different than what is on the hospital menu and offer to go to the cafeteria to fetch what they wish after checking with the nursing staff if what the patient has requested is amenable to the patient's health.
- Advocate for every patient if some aspect of their stay in the ED does not meet their expectations. The resource nurse and the nurse manager oversee this aspect of the duties of the patient ambassador.
- Train new volunteers, high school and college interns to the practices of the Emergency Department through modeling while working staff and patients.
- Assist patients to the bathroom if the nursing staff approves or find a portable toilet if the patient is on oxygen and cannot walk safely to the bathroom.
- Form strong work relationships with the myriad of people who work within the healthcare system from the clinical providers to the kitchen staff to security officers and everyone in between. Welcome the knowledge that each service provides to acquire useful information for the many situations that arise daily within the Emergency Department.
- Accompany the bereaved when a patient dies, whether to stand with them in the Trauma room, the privacy of the Family Room or at the bedside.
- Use kindness, intelligent knowledge, humor when needed and compassion with every person who enters the department.
- Other duties as needed and assigned.
